It was discovered that while the published results led one to believe that increases in spatial scores were realized in all three of the Stanford-Binet tasks, the only test that had shown increases was the paper-folding and cutting task.

Similar questions appear on IQ tests such as the WISC-V and the Stanford-Binet. Paper folding is a measure of visual-spatial awareness. Students review a series of pictures that show a piece of paper being folded and cut. Students must determine what the paper will look like when it is unfolded.

The Stanford-Binet is a standardized test, meaning that norms were established during the design phase of the test by administering the test to a large, representative sample of the test population. The test has a mean, or average, standard score of 100 and a standard deviation of 16 (subtests have a mean of 50 and a standard deviation of 8).
